- Membership includes one Representative and one Alternate
- Mission: Members perform audit services at the highest industry performance standards while eliminating the redundancy and costs associated with duplicate supplier audits.

# NIAC FORMATION – FOUNDED IN 1994

(as Nuclear Industry Assessment COUNDING MEMBERS ▶ 11 founding members

- Goal: cost saving by sharing common supplier audits using subcontracted auditing services logic
- Challenge: develop a charter that addresses legal concerns including anti-trust issues

### MEMBERSHIP IN NIAC

Members must:

- Maintain a Program meeting 10CFR50 App. B, or equivalent, and accept 10CFR21.
- Maintain Lead Auditor qualifications compliant with ASME NQA-1 or ANSI N45.2.23 and require written examination only.
- Sign Corporation Membership Agreement form
- Pay membership dues
- Follow Bylaws and supplemental procedures
- Attend annual member meeting
- Conduct assessments as a safety related service
- Obtain supplier authorization to perform and share audits
- Plan/perform assessments using standard checklist(s)
- Provide audit plans/reports/follow up to sharing members





#### NIAC PROCESS

- Members submit supplier audit requests for the following year.
- Member organizations are assigned to perform supplier assessments, no joint member assessments.
- Based on a standardized approach
- Use membership approved standard checklists appropriate to the scope
- Checklists identify the applicable criteria of 10CFR50 Appendix B, 10CFR21, 10CFR50.55(e), ANSI N45.2, ASME Section III NCA3800/NCA400, ASME NQA-1, 10CFR71 Subpart H, and 10CFR72 Subpart G
- Supplemental checklists: Calibration, Software, NDE Personnel, Commercial Grade Survey




### **BENEFITS OF NIAC MEMBERSHIP**
