

#### AUDIT VERSUS SURVEY, THE RIGHT TOOL FOR THE RIGHT JOB!

Commercial grade surveys should not be confused with audits. The terms "commercial grade survey" and "audit" have been observed being used by dedicating entities interchangeably and resulted in inadequate implementation of Method 2 for verification of critical characteristics. Although both types of assessments have similar general requirements for planning, performance and reporting results, their purpose and focus is not the same. The purpose of an audit is to determine the adequacy of and compliance with procedures, instructions, and drawings typically in accordance with an industry regulation or standard. The purpose of the commercial grade survey is establish if the supplier of a commercial grade item or service has documented quality controls in place that adequately control the critical characteristics that have been determined by the dedicating entity. Both the audit and commercial grade survey will evaluate the supplier's quality controls/ processes; however, unlike a commercial grade survey, an audit may not require identification of critical characteristics resulting in a potentially inadequate assessment of the supplier's ability to sufficiently control the specified critical characteristics quality controls will be used as the basis for verification of one or more critical characteristics for the dedication of items and services should be conducted as a commercial grade survey.

#### NUPIC MONITORS VENDOR PERFORMANCE

The NUPIC Vendor Performance Monitoring Committee (VPMC) performs an evaluation of vendor performance 3 times a year. The results of this evaluation are presented to the NUPIC membership at each meeting with recommendations for action. The information listed below is collected and evaluated to develop an overall rating for each vendor:

Receipt Inspection Results Audit Findings Timely Closure of Audit Findings NRC Inspection Results Industry Operating Experience 10CFR21 Notifications NUPIC Industry Issues Audit Team Recommendations

Based on the results of the evaluation each vendor receives a rating of Green, White, Yellow, or Red. Vendors with Yellow or Red ratings are considered for increased oversight. The results of the VPMC evaluation are posted on the NUPIC web site. Vendors can obtain access to their results and are encouraged to review their report frequently. Vendors can log in at <u>www.nupic.com</u> to review the VPMC evaluations. #### **CONTROL OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

Have you noticed the proprietary use statement on NUPIC Audit and Survey Reports? The NUPIC Audit and Survey Process was changed recently to add a notification to audit and survey reports stating that these reports are the intellectual property of the lead utility for the activity. This means that they <u>cannot be shared with non-NUPIC Members</u> without the express written permission of the lead utility.

NUPIC Audit and Survey Reports contain proprietary information that is not intended for public distribution. NRC Licensees are entitled to the information by merit of their NUPIC Membership. The audited or surveyed company is, of course, the recipient. But no unauthorized distribution beyond this, by either NUPIC Members or the audited or surveyed company, is allowed.

FUKUSHIMA TSUNAMI RESULT IN US NUCLEAR PLANT MODIFICATIONS

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has issued new orders for U.S. plants as a result of the March 11, 2011 earthquake that occurred off the coast of Japan, which resulted in a tsunami that caused considerable damage to the Fukushima Dai-ichi Nuclear Station. The NRC assembled a response task force to investigate and review the event. The task force recommended a series of actions to be taken by each licensee. Two of the required plant modifications involve the installation of reliable hardened containment vents and spent fuel pool instrumentation. The following is a brief description of the NRC Orders issued on March 12, 2012 for all U.S. nuclear plants with an operating license, COL (Combined Operating License) or CP (Construction Permit):

<u>NRC Order EA-12-050</u>, "Issuance of Order to Modify Licenses with Regard to Reliable Hardened Containment Vents." This order requires all Boiling Water Reactor (BWR) Mark I and Mark II containments to have a reliable hardened vent to remove decay heat and maintain control of containment pressure within acceptable limits following events that result in the loss of active containment heat removal capability or prolonged Station Blackout.

<u>NRC Order EA-12-051</u>, "Issuance of Order to Modify Licenses with Regard to Reliable Spent Fuel Pool Instrumentation." This order requires that licensees install reliable means of remotely monitoring wide range spent fuel pool levels to support effective prioritization of event mitigation and recovery actions in the event of a beyond design basis external event.

Licensees are required to have full implementation of the NRC Orders by December 2016, or within two refueling outages.
